BOARD MEETING

MINUTES

January 13, 1982

The regular monthly meeting of the Board of Directors of the Bellwood Public Library was called to order at 8:10 p.m. by President Mrs. Clifford in the library meeting room.

Attendance: Present were Mr. Lyons, Mrs. Sabel, Dr. Fletcher, Mrs. Meller, and Mrs. Clifford. Mr. Harris, the Head Librarian, was also in attendance. Mr. Riley was absent.

Minutes: The minutes of the December 9, 1981, Board meeting were approved as received. A motion was made by Mrs. Sabel, seconded by Dr. Fletcher, to accept and place on file the minutes of the December 9, 1981, Board meeting. The motion passed unanimously.

Review and/or Revision of Agenda: President Mrs. Clifford asked the Board to review and/or revise the Agenda as appropriate. The Agenda was accepted as written by a unanimous agreement.

Finance Committee Report:

The Administration Committee also recommends that the By-Laws be amended to read that the work schedule for pages shall not exceed 29 hours per week under any circumstances.
